"The joint venture project between DOME and STRAKKA RACING to compete in the 2014 Le Mans 24H Race with DOME S103 has been cancelled for several reasons."

Following a thrilling Le Mans 24 Hours, DOME continues to progress development of the new Strakka DOME S103 LMP2 car. This exciting and innovative project, the first DOME to be built outside of Japan and first with British team Strakka Racing, was due to make its competition debut at La Sarthe last week.

Through excellent teamwork and the hard work of the engineers and suppliers, an all-new car was created, assembled and tested in record time. Regretfully, a number of late issues and a subsequent testing crash in the run up to this year's race meant that together with partner Strakka Racing we made the difficult to decision to withdraw from the event.

As long time participants and enthusiasts of the iconic Le Mans race, DOME apologises to the organisers, its partners and fans that it could be not be present this year but assures all parties that together with Strakka Racing, DOME will be back on track very soon.
